Young Person Application Pack

We would like to invite you to join us for the 26th World Scout Jamboree taking place in Gdańsk, Poland in summer 2027. This is a once in a lifetime experience to share a camp with 50,000 Scouts from across 150 countries and territories from around the world!

The World Scout Jamboree is one of the most significant events in the global Scouting movement, bringing together thousands of young people from around the world to celebrate unity, adventure, and cultural exchange. Held approximately every four years, the Jamboree is a gathering unlike any other, offering Scouts the opportunity to experience a world of diversity while participating in activities that foster personal growth, leadership, and global citizenship.

In West Lancashire, we have 36 places available for you to become a part of our unit which will travel and represent Scouting in this area of the world, along with four leaders. South Ribble has 5 of these places to allocate.

The information in this pack will give you much more detail about the experience and the opportunity, that you should not miss!

The Jamboree will take place from approx. July 30th to August 8th 2027. (this is flight/transport dependant and may fluctuate by a couple of days either side) Further activities will be built around these core dates. This will most likely include a couple of days in city or town local to the site and also maybe Home Hospitality or Hosted visit to another Scout group in either of the countries above. This is not yet known, but the possibilities are there!

This application pack starts by giving you some information about the once in a lifetime experience of the World Scout Jamboree. Being held in the stunning **Wyspa Sobieszewska (Sobieszewo Island) in Gdańsk, Poland.**

The 26th World Scout Jamboree will be a gathering of Scouts from almost every country in the world, and it really will be the experience of a lifetime for those lucky enough to take part. It's bigger than the Olympics, in terms of participants and also the countries represented. You'll live and take part in adventurous activities alongside Scouts from all over the world, making new friends and experiencing different cultures you never knew existed!

Information about the site.

The 26th World Scout Jamboree Site is located on Wyspa Sobieszewska within the borders of the city of Gdańsk, on the coast of the Baltic Sea in northern Poland.

Gdańsk has 1,000 years of history and has been influenced by many cultures, religions, and events through the ages. It is the birthplace of the Solidarity Movement, which began as a labour union led by the later Nobel Peace Prize laureate Lech Wałęsa, and evolved into a protest movement that contributed to the fall of Communism in Poland and Eastern Europe.

Scouts will enjoy exploring the natural wonders of Wyspa Sobieszewska. It is surrounded by the sea and rivers and is a 20-minute drive from the historic centre of Gdańsk.

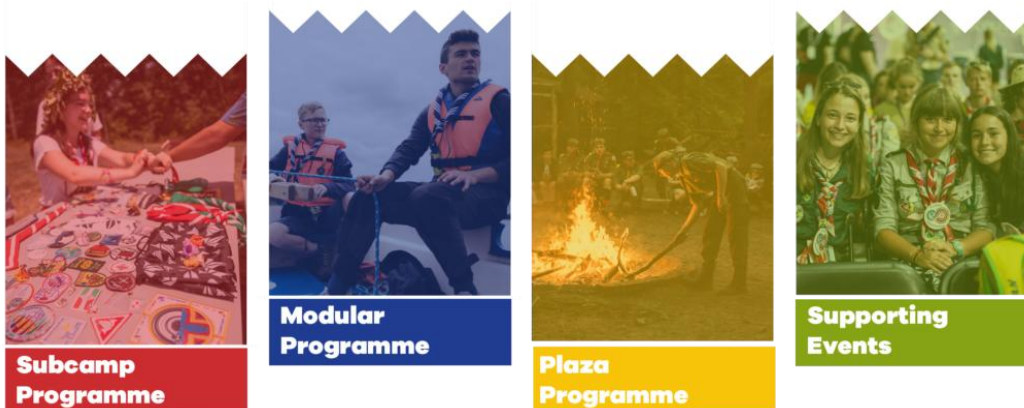
Although Wyspa Sobieszewska is a part of Gdańsk, it has preserved its charming natural environment and is located away from urban development areas. Wyspa Sobieszewska enjoys the status of an ecological reserve and was formed by regulating the estuary of the Vistula River as it flows into the Baltic Sea. Its natural features and microclimate make it an ideal place for outdoor activities during the summer. It offers various landscapes, including the seaside forest, several kilometres of wide beach, picturesque open fields, and farmland. The Jamboree site itself is located on 300 hectares of fields and meadows, with programme activities areas in the forest and on the beach.

Information about the programme

The Jamboree starts with the Opening Ceremony on 30 July 2027 and continues until the Closing Ceremony on 8 August 2027. The educational programme will contain: the main programme modules, plaza activities, programmes offered in subcamps, the International Day, the Inter-Religious Ceremony, Faith & Beliefs Zone and many more activities. Additionally, there will be a programme designed for the IST.

Educational activities during the programme modules will be supported by other non-governmental organizations (NGOs). The off-site modules will involve local communities in the host area, allowing Scouts to explore the history and culture of the Kashubian and Pomerania regions near Gdańsk.

The Jamboree programme will consist of four components:



Subcamp Programme

Life in subcamps is a huge part of the Jamboree experience. We want to ensure the participants thrive in a safe environment, building strong friendships and having fun. To that end, we will have special free time activities and the one-of-the-kind Solidarity Badge that will encourage Scouts to explore how bravery, peace, and friendship can change the world.

Modular Programme

The Modular Program will follow our “Bravely” theme. Participants will embark on adventures on-site, close-to-site and off-site, encouraging them to be courageous in their lives and communities. Every day will bring something new, allowing the participants to explore different areas and grow physically, spiritually, socially, and mentally. Participants will roam through forests, play on the beach, run around the city of Gdańsk, visit a Polish Scout camp, and much more.

Plaza Programme

The Plaza Programme will help participants experience different cultures and ideas. In the national tents, the participants will see presentations and displays from every contingent. The Faiths and Beliefs Zone will address their spiritual needs, while the Equality Zone will introduce them to friends from diverse communities, allowing them to exchange experiences without judgment.

Supporting Events

The Jamboree will feature several events that explore the “Bravely” theme in the past, present and future. During one of them, Youth Forum – a model UN debate, the participants will discuss ongoing issues and find real-life solutions to these problems. The 120 Years of Scouting Celebration will familiarise them with great figures who have brought change to the world. Also, a unique opportunity, the participants will be able to play a special Jamboree board game.

IMPRESSED YET?

Cost...

The UK Contingent are currently working on the cost for the participants from the UK, which is envisaged will be in line with previous Jamborees. However, we are not yet certain on this.

The cost of the Jamboree will be £3,350. This includes the cost of the Jamboree plus local team building and Unit preparation activities. This will be payable in instalments on dates still to be set by the Jamboree leadership team.

This cost is broken down as follows–

West Lancs County funding 25%	£837.50
South Ribble District funding 33%	£1105.50
Participant to fund remaining 42%	£1407
total	£3350

As well as fundraising on your own, we could organise fund raising activities to help pay for the Jamboree as a District, and it is hoped your own Group and Unit will also help with this. We will of course support the fundraising aspect – whether individual or as a group - throughout the preparation and help and advice will be available always, and we mean always!

There is no reason that you should not be able to go to the Jamboree because of money. There will be a lot of support available for you from each other and from the Unit Leaders.

What sort of Young People are we Looking for? ...

The following points will be considered when deciding whether or not a young person is right to attend a World Scout Jamboree:

- An ability to be involved in Youth Shaped Scouting
- An eagerness to develop as a person
- An interest in international Scouting
- An ability to work in a team
- A commitment to Scouting beyond the Jamboree
- An ability to take responsibility for yourself
- The impact the Jamboree will have on the person
- Whether or not the young person is likely to be able to cope with upto 3 weeks away from home, having been through any organised Unit training

Youth Shaped Scouting...

To meet our Vision, young people within the unit will have the chance to have their voice heard on all aspects of the Jamboree, including programme and activity planning and the way that their unit is run.

This is to ensure that Scouting meets their needs and remains relevant to their interests and aims of the Jamboree.

- Youth Shaped Scouting includes young people doing the following:
- Sharing their ideas
- Learning from and teaching each other and adults
- Taking part in decision making
- Assisting with planning the programme, including activities and camps
- Becoming more involved in all aspects of Scouting

Applications are open now.

The date that applications must be submitted and received will be **Tues March 31st 2026** this includes the date that mail should arrive, not the day of postage.

ALL applicants will be invited to the Selection event under canvas.

This will be held on **Saturday 11th April 2026 from 1100 to Sunday 12th April 2026 1100.**

This will be the only selection date.

This date along with the training dates below are pre-requisite conditions that must be met to be considered. **Non-attendance to training or other jamboree organised meetings will forfeit your place if successful.**

Please ensure you are available and can commit to **ALL** the dates below before submitting your application.

The Jamboree will take place from approx. July 30th to August 8th 2027. Further activities will be built around these core dates. This will most likely include a couple of days in city and potentially Hosted Hospitality in Poland to visit to another Scout group.
